The Committee direct that the interim conditions be reordered, and that Mr Onafuwa is required to comply with the following conditions:

- 1. He must not undertake, or be involved in any way with, any online prescribing and/or dispensing prescriptions generated from online prescribing services.
- 2. He must tell the GPhC before he takes on any position for which he must be registered with the GPhC;
- 3. He must give the GPhC the details of the role and the hours he will work each week;
- 4. He must give the GPhC the contact details of your employer, Superintendent Pharmacist, and or pharmacy owner;
- 5. He must tell the following people in writing about the restrictions imposed on his pharmacy practice, if he is doing any paid or unpaid work for which he must be registered with the GPhC. He should do this within 2 weeks of the date of this order taking effect:
- All employers or contractors
- Agents acting on behalf of employers and locum agencies
- Superintendent Pharmacists
- Responsible Pharmacists
- Line managers
 - 6. If he is applying for work, he must tell any prospective employer about the restrictions imposed on his pharmacy practice when he applies.
