You must:

- 1. Tell the GPhC in writing before taking on any position for which you must be registered with the GPhC;*
- 2. Give the GPhC in writing details of the role and the hours you will work each week, including locum and relief work as a Pharmacist and as an independent prescriber;*
- 3. Give the GPhC in writing the contact details of your employer, Superintendent Pharmacist and/or pharmacy owner.*

4. *Tell the following people in writing (within two weeks of the date this Order takes effect), about the restrictions imposed on your pharmacy practice, if you are doing any paid or unpaid work for which you must be registered with the GPhC:*

I. All employers or contractors

II. Agents acting on behalf of employers and locum agencies

III. Superintendent pharmacists

IV. Responsible pharmacists

V. Line managers

VI. Accountable officers for controlled drugs

VII. The NHS England area team or equivalent organisation/s within any relevant nation of Great Britain.

a. Send the GPhC a copy of this notification.

b. Tell any prospective employer about the restrictions imposed on your pharmacy practice when you apply for work.

5. *Tell the GPhC if you apply for work as a Pharmacist outside Great Britain.*

6. *Not provide mail-order or online pharmacy services.*

7. *Not work as a sole practitioner or Superintendent Pharmacist.*

8.

a. Have no involvement in the ownership or management of any pharmacy.

b. Limit your pharmacy practice to premises registered by GPhC and primary care settings.

c. Limit your prescribing practice to NHS funded services and not undertake any privately funded services.
