1. *You must:*
  - a. *give the GPhC the contact details of your place of employment and anyone who is likely to be the manager or persons supervising you (employer, pharmacy owner, agency, superintendent pharmacist responsible pharmacist).*



*If you are not employed, you must ask the GPhC to approve your workplace supervisor before you start work.*

- 11. You must arrange for your workplace supervisor to send a report on your progress and development in relation to general pharmacy work directly to the GPhC every three months or when the GPhC ask for one.*
- 12. You must undertake training that is necessary to fulfil the role in which you are practising as a pharmacist. The training is to be paid for by you. You must send the GPhC evidence of completion within 10 days of the course.*
- 13. You must not take on any:*
  - a. on-call duties; or*
  - b. extended-hours work.*
- 14. You must not work as a:*
  - a. sole practitioner;*
  - b. superintendent pharmacist;*
  - c. responsible pharmacist; or*
  - d. locum or relief pharmacist.*
