- 1. You must tell the GPhC before you take on any position for which you must be registered with the GPhC;*
- 2. You must give the GPhC the details of the role and the hours you will work each week;*
- 3. You must give the GPhC the contact details of your employer, Superintendent Pharmacist, and or pharmacy owner;*
- 4. You must tell the following people in writing about the restrictions imposed on your pharmacy practice, if you are doing any paid or unpaid work for which you must be registered with the GPhC. You should do this within 2 weeks of the date of this order taking effect:*
  - All employers or contractors*
  - Agents acting on behalf of employers and locum agencies*

- *Superintendent Pharmacists*
- *Responsible Pharmacists*
- *Line managers*

5. *If you are applying for work, you must tell any prospective employer about the restrictions imposed on your pharmacy practice when you apply;*

6. *You must not undertake, or be involved in any way with, any online prescribing and/or dispensing prescriptions generated from online prescribing services.”*
